## 7th edition of the PediatricSimulationGames

Given the success of the previous editions of the PediatricSimulationGames, the Latina campus of Sapienza University of Rome will organize the 2025 edition of the Games again this year. The PediatricSimulationGames are now a stable event dedicated to residents of pediatric schools aimed at acquiring the latest knowledge in the field of emergency pediatrics.

The 7th edition of the PediatricSimulationGames will be held in Latina, between the 3rd and 6th of September 2025.

**Because of its training and educational purpose in the field of pediatric emergency care, it is preferable that the team be composed of residents from the first three years of the course.**

The mood will be 'learning to play' and 'playing to learn'.

*Learning to play:* in a friendly but highly technical competition, as in the last edition we will have an international jury composed of four major figures of the global Pediatric Emergency Care, that will handle the education debriefings at the end of each session. Even more judges could be invited according to the number of international teams participating.

*Playing to learn:* we know from the evaluation they completed that the residents started studying a long time before the event and have continued studying even after the Games, preparing for next edition in order to improve and compete.

Also, this year's games will be enriched by the special **"the torchbearer of the PSGs"** awards, which will be given to the teams that, based on the jury's judgment, have distinguished themselves by:

- **the best teamwork**
- **the best management of CPR**
- **the best airway management**

To allow each team to play more, the Games will consist of four rounds, which will compete in simulated emergency pediatrics for three days in a row. At the end of the rounds, there will be a final between the top 4 teams. If there are more than 32 teams, a new round will be organized for every 8 new teams.

Application to the Games will be open from march 1 to April 15 according to the rules of this manual.
